STADIUM POLICY

Wilkes County Schools desires to provide a positive experience that is reflective of the family atmosphere that we desire and in accordance with GHSA sportsmanship policy. In effort to ensure a safe, secure environment, we will implement the following new policies.

GENERAL POLICIES

- All fans are subject to search upon entering the stadium by the Wilkes County Sheriff's Department.
- No weapons allowed.
- Tobacco/vaping products, drugs, controlled substances, or alcohol are not allowed on the premises.
- All spectators must be seated on either the visitor or home side of the field and remain there until the end of the game.
- No standing along the fence or end zone areas.
- No loitering in any area in or around the stadium.
- Students in grades 8 or below must be accompanied by an adult or parent to enter into the game. Students may bring their Student ID to verify their grade level.
- All students must remain on the home side of the field with an adult.
- No re-entry allowed. A new ticket must be purchased.
- No entry after ticket sales are over.
- Glass bottles and containers are not allowed.
- Be courteous to all spectators in language and action.
- Individuals who are removed from the stadium will not be allowed to attend events sponsored by Wilkes County Schools.

TICKET BOOTH & SALES

- Two ticket lines will exist on the home side: One line for online tickets and season tickets, and one line for those needing to purchase tickets.
- Metal detectors will be used at all entrances.
